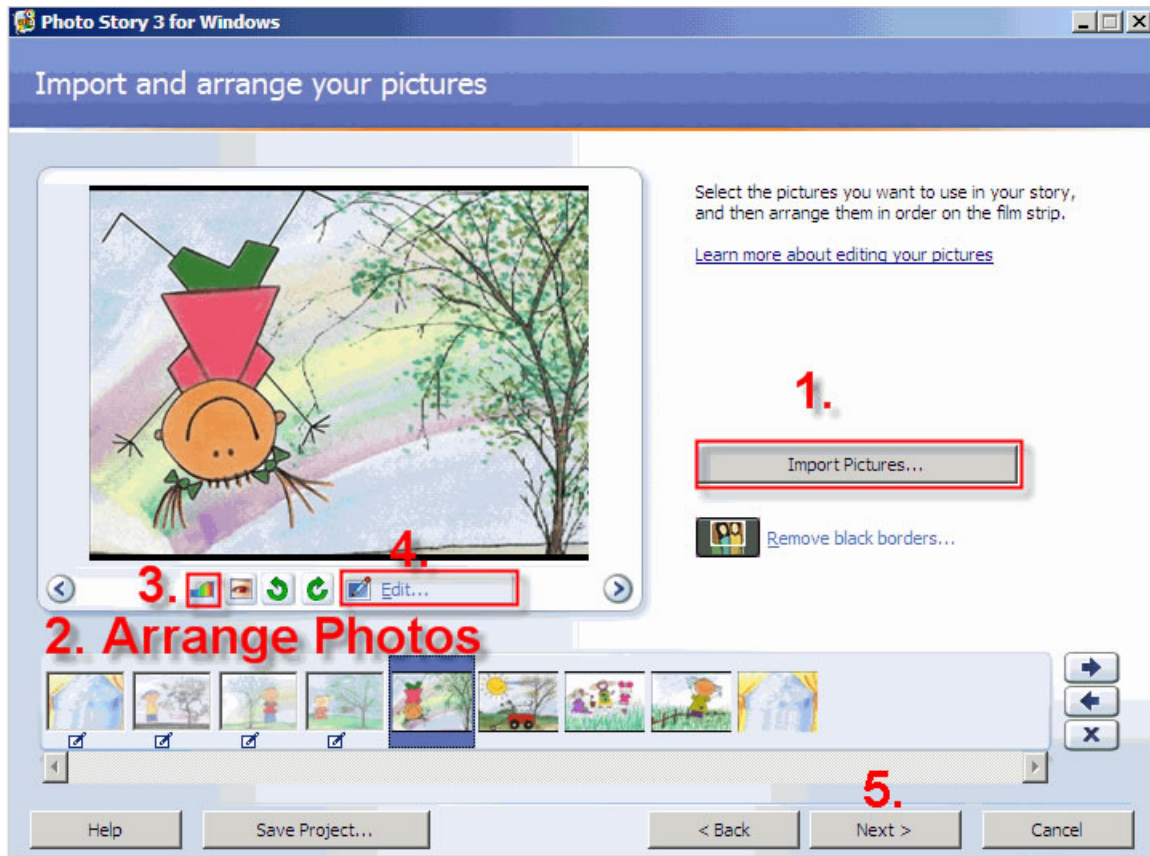


Photo Story 3/How to Make a Slideshow

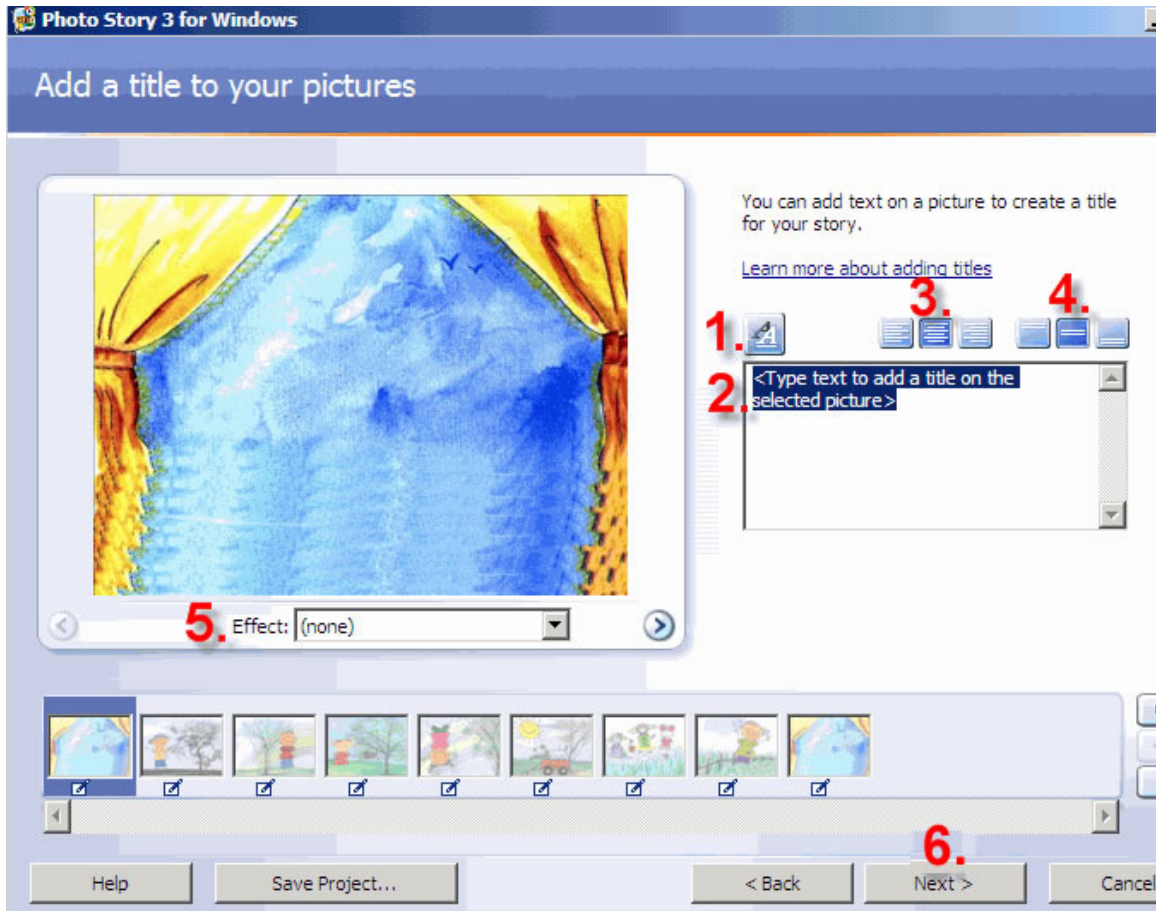

Open Photo Story 3



1. Import photos
2. Arrange photos by clicking and dragging
3. Click on the photo you want to enhance the color, then click this icon
4. Click the Edit button to rotate and crop, auto fix, or add effects to the photo
5. Click next to add text to your photos

Add a Title to Your Pictures



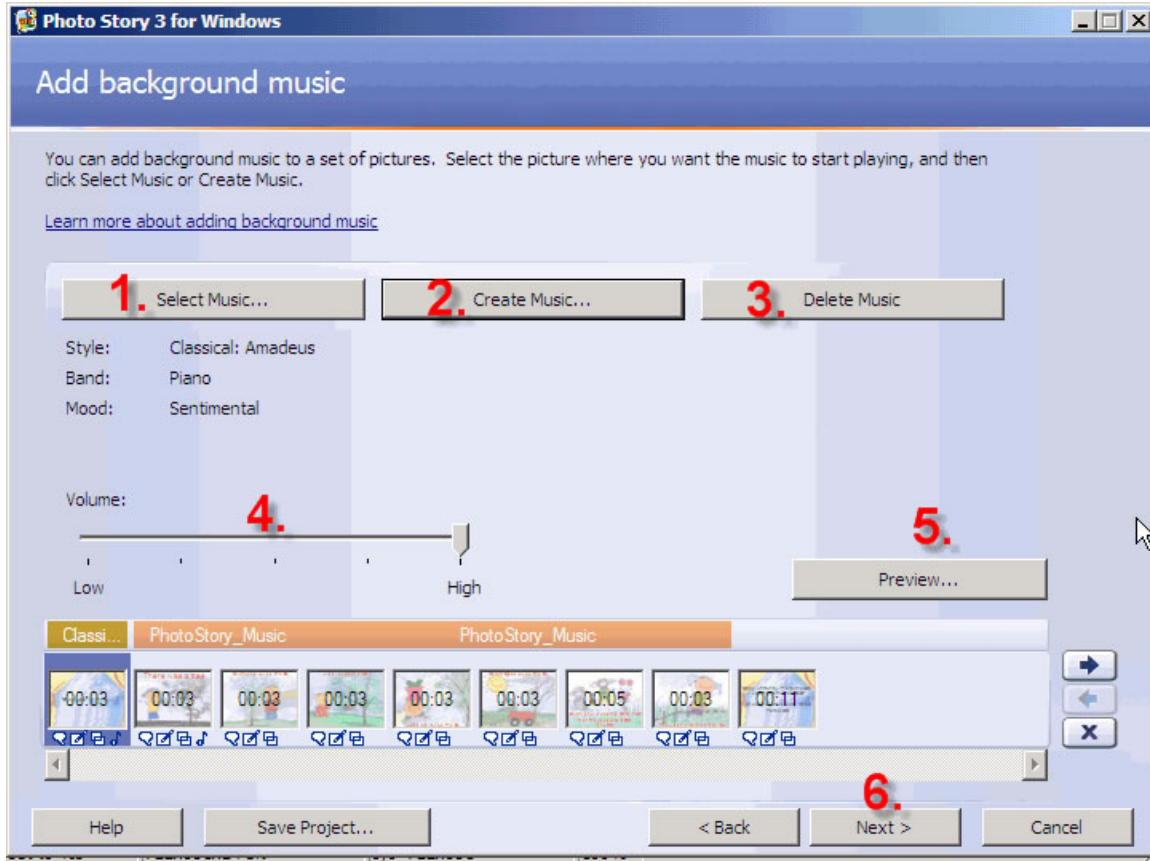
1. Click on this button to open the text options dialog box to change the font, font style, size, effects, and color
2. Type your text in this box
3. Click on these buttons to align text left, center horizontally, or right
4. Click on these buttons to align top, center vertically, and bottom
5. Click the drop down list to add effects to each photo
6. Click next to narrate your pictures and customize motion

Narrate Your Pictures and Customize Motion



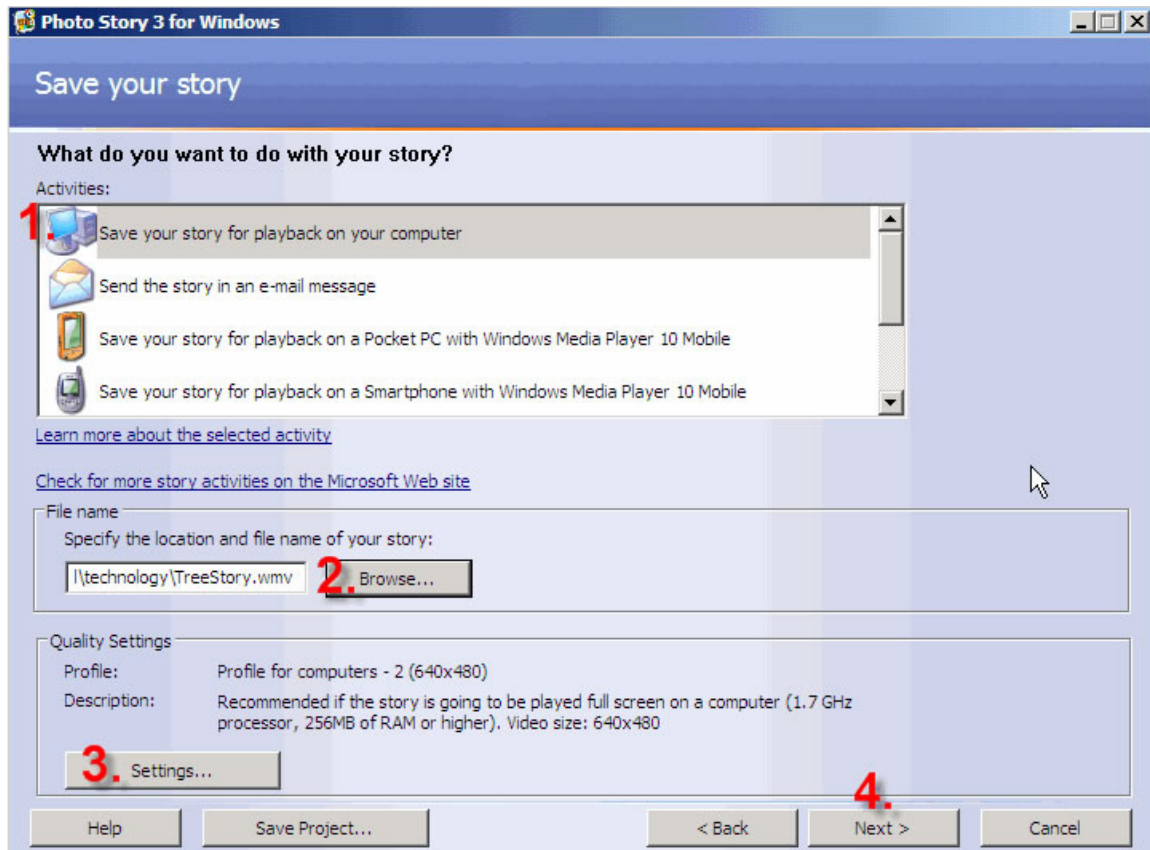
1. Click here to configure microphone and set recording volume
2. Click here to start recording your narration
3. Click here to stop recording
4. Click here to delete narration for a particular slide
5. Click here to set motion/duration and transition
6. Type notes in this area
7. Click here to see a preview of your slideshow
8. Click this arrow to move slides to a different spot (you can also drag slides by holding down the left mouse key and dragging to a new location)
9. Click here while a slide is selected to delete it
10. Click next to add background music to your slideshow

Add Background Music



1. Click **Select Music...** to select previously saved music
2. Click here to create music from a variety of genres
3. Click here to delete a previously selected music selection
4. Move the slider to adjust the volume of the music
5. Click here to see a preview of the music selection playing with the slideshow
6. Click next to go to the save your story dialog box

Save Your Story



1. Select what you want to do with your story
2. Click the **Browse** button to tell the computer where you want to save this file
3. Click the **settings** button to change the settings for the movie
4. Click the **next** button to build your story
